- a. Playoff format – 2 weeks total points or just 1 week (to allow for shorter season & allow more time to plan for banquet and such) – this was not discussed, but starting date of September 23 and ending the season at April 13th should be sufficient time
- b. Change up the plaques? – will be reviewed at Captain's meeting scheduled in January – Colleen to meet with Chris Thorne to review options and send to captains for a majority consensus
- c. Banquet @ Polish May 9 – music, dancing – do we want something else? – discussed tipping more to the servers, again will review at Captains meeting in January along with possibly a different venue for following year
- d. Absolutely no outside food or drink while playing (unless authorized by venue or by special request for birthday, Christmas, etc... no timmies, no water bottles, energy drinks, etc.)
- e. Players indoor sports bar is looking for up to 2 teams and paying half the league fees for the first year – no teams interested, space is not ideal for players
- f. Uneven number of teams – how do we want to schedule playoffs? Not an issue this year
- g. We ended up with a larger surplus in the account than we expected because the people that said "maybe" were not confirmed and did not know how many of the confirmed numbers were guests or players to budget for the cash back at the door. This year, we will ask that when you confirm your numbers, you let us know how many players, and will expect that any "maybes" are confirmed one week before the actual banquet
- h. Youth darts – donation to league of requested by Dawn Loveys - \$200 suggested by Steve Ropp, voted on & passed
- i. Recognizing players that hit 171s throughout the year along with 180s hit during playoffs
